

CHARLESTOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT SEX OFFENDER FACT SHEET NOTIFICATION OF RELEASE IN RHODE ISLAND



RISK LEVEL II1 (HIGH)

In additional to Level I&11 notification (other law enforcement agencies, victims/witnesses to the offense committed by the offender) law enforcement may notify schools and daycare centers, providers, other organizations and community members that primarily serve or may come into contact with individuals likely to encounter the offender.

The Police Department named above is releasing the following information pursuant to RI General Laws \$11-37.1-1 et seq., also known as the Sexual Offender Registration and Community Notification Act. This individual is subject to community notification of his pending release pursuant to RI General Laws \$11-37.1-12 of the Act, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender's release from prison when the Sex Offender Board of Review determines that the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of Criminal Sexual Conduct or other statutes which requires the individual to register with law enforcement pursuant to RI Gen. Laws \$11-37.1 et seq of the Act.

This offender is not wanted by the police at this time and has served the sentence imposed on him by the court. This notification is not to increase fear in the community. It is the belief of law enforcement that an informed public is a safe public.

Except as provided by law, court order or other legal prohibition, Law Enforcement may not direct where the offender does or does not reside, nor direct where the offender works or goes to school. The risk level of this offender has been determined based largely on his potential to re-offend.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities, but it was not until passage of the Sexual Offender Registration and Community Notification Act that law enforcement was formally notified of their residence. In many of these cases, law enforcement is now able to share information with you. However, abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate or harass registered offenders will not be tolerated and may be a crime. Further, such abuse could potentially end law enforcement's ability to engage in community notifications.
